# Minutes of Regular Meeting February 12<sup>th</sup> 2025

The East Lampeter Sewer Authority met on Wednesday, February 12th, 2025, at 4:00PM at the Township Building 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA. 17602.

### A. Sanitary Sewer:

i. Stauffer Run Upgrade

Mr. Cichy reported that Envirep, Inc. (Gorman-Rupp pump manufacturer's representative has recommended installing trimmed impellers in pumps 1 and 2, change the v-belt drive to a 1:1 ratio, and run the motors at full speed. This was already done to pump #3 and is working fine now.

#### ii. CFA Funding-

a. Oaks #2 Elimination Project

Mr. Thomas reported that he spoke to Mr. Nissley. It was a positive conversation, and Mr. Nissley would like to meet Mr. Thomas in the spring to see the area. Mr. Thomas will follow up in March 2025.

#### b. Hobson Road Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Mr. Cichy informed that Mr. Rehab has completed the CCTV investigation and the next step is to install the CIPP liners in the sewer main. There needs to be a change order to manhole MH-F44 which is currently an outside drop connection. Staff would like it to be an inside drop connection.

Motion 1<sup>st</sup> by Mr. Stumpf to accept Mr. Rehab change order in the amount of \$1,400.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Clark. Motion carried.

c. Stauffer Run PS Wet Well Lining Project

No update. The contractor will work on it in late winter/early spring 2025.

iii. Strasburg Pike Project

Mr. Cichy reported that HRG is working on the Design Engineer's Report for the project and the PADEP Water Quality Management Permit application.

iv. Tapping Fee Analysis

Mr. Cichy discussed the sewer tapping fee table which outlined the fees in the local municipalities surrounding East Lampeter Township. After lengthy discussion, the item will be on the next meeting agenda to continue the discussion.

#### B. Stormwater:

i. PRP Update

Ms. Hitchens reported that their meeting with DEP went well. Almost everyother project was approved by DEP. In the future there will not be PRP. It will be based on the volume. The current permit has been extended for now.
