## Minutes of Regular Meeting May 14<sup>th</sup> 2025

The East Lampeter Sewer Authority met on Wednesday May 14th, 2025 at 4:00PM at the Township Building 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA. 17602.

#### **Old Business:**

#### A. Sanitary Sewer:

i. Stauffer Run Upgrade

Mr. Cichy reported that Gorman-Rupp has provided the trimmed impellers to Envirep, however Envirep is still waiting for the new belt/sheave assemblies.

#### ii. CFA Funding-

a. Oaks #2 Elimination Project

Mr. Thomas has not been able to contact Mr. Nissley; however, efforts are still being made to reach out to him.

#### b. Stauffer Run PS Wet Well Lining Project

Mr. Cichy reported that the contractor Utility Services Group was delayed due to equipment repairing. They are scheduled to finish week of May 26<sup>th</sup> 2025 or June 2, 2025. HRG is still waiting to hear back from Pa. Department of Labor and Industry to confirm that this is a maintenance project and therefore excluded from the prevailing wage rates.

#### iii. Strasburg Pike Project

Mr. Cichy reported that Township staff is reviewing the PADEP Water Quality Management Permit application drawings. Once the staff comments are provided to HRG, it will be incorporated into the Permit application to DEP. Motion 1<sup>st</sup> by Mr. Clark to approve the Pa. Department of Transportation applicant's authorization for agent to apply for highway occupancy permit application. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Scalyer. Motion carried.

#### iv. Millbridge Village Campground

Mr. Thomas informed the board that there is a new owner at the campground. Mr. Thomas met the new owner and informed that they will be required to submit the necessary paperwork or close the new lines that were installed. Mr. Thomas informed also that the new owner was not aware of the stream bank restoration that was done a few years ago and it appeared that they may have cut the shrubs that were supposed to be there to maintain the stream bank. The staff was going to verify once the water level subsided. There was a discussion that the water meter is read at the campground site and Paradise Twp. is billed accordingly since the campground is located in Paradise Twp.

Since there were no comments from the board, the resolution will be prepared in the final document for consideration at the next board meeting.
