RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE SEWER RENTALS AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF SEWER LINES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Township of East Lampeter has, from time to time, made additions, extensions and expansions to the East Lampeter Township Sewer System, and has, from time to time, fixed, charged and collected rentals and other charges for the use of said sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Lampeter has determined that it is necessary to adjust the rentals and other charges for the use of the aforesaid sewer system as set forth on the attached schedule.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

- 1. The rentals and other charges imposed upon and shall be collected from the owner of each property served by the East Lampeter Township Sewer System and having the use thereof, whether direct or indirect, are adjusted in accordance with the attached schedule.
- 2. The quarterly sewer rentals or charges imposed by this resolution shall be effective January 1, 2026, and remain in effect until amended or repealed by further resolution or ordinance of the Township of East Lampeter.
- 3. Any resolution or ordinance, or part thereof, which is inconsistent with this resolution, is hereby declared to be repealed. All other rules, regulations and provisions regarding the use of the East Lampeter Township Sewer System heretofore adopted either by resolution or ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
