## Minutes of Regular Meeting November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The East Lampeter Sewer Authority met on Wednesday November 12th, 2025, at 4:00PM at the Township Building 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA. 17602.

The meeting is being conducted virtually utilizing Zoom, which is a cloud-based platform for remote video and audio conferencing. The meeting is being recorded.

#### A. Sanitary Sewer:

## i. CFA Funding-

a. Oaks PS#2 Elimination Project

Mr. Cichy reported that PennDOT had one comment which HRG is addressing. Also, DEP WO&E application is being reviewed currently. Solicitor Crème is in the process of working on the acquisition of easements that are required.

b. Stauffer Run PS Wet Well Lining Project

Mr. Cichy reported that Utility Services Group (USG) has completed the work and has submitted a bill for payment which was approved thru the requisition.

## ii. Strasburg Pike Project

Mr. Cichy explained that PennDOT HOP application was approved. The DEP WO&E application is currently being reviewed. Solicitor Crème is in the process of working on the acquisition of the easements that are required. Due to the delay Mr. Cichy hopes to have the project out to bid next month.

iii. Rockvale Sewer Capacity Reservation & Improvement Agreement
After a brief discussion, Motion 1<sup>st</sup> by Mr. Scalyer to approve the Sewer Capacity
Reservation and Improvements Agreement between East Lampeter Sewer
Authority and MP Lancaster 1 LLC (developer) dated November 12, 2025.
2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Patel. Motion carried.

#### iv. Kettle & Fire

Mr. Brian Heck, CEO of Kettle & Fire discussed his thoughts about being a good business operator that wants to be in compliance to all the Township and Authority requirements. Mr. Joe Guzek with Guzek Associates, Inc., explained the steps that are being taken at the plant to recycle the water so that there would be minimal discharge into the sewer system. They have signed contracts for temporary pretreatment facilities until they can get their permits to build permanent facilities onsite. The board does not require Kettle & Fire to update the board each month but should be in contact with the staff and keep them updated. The board thanked the Kettle & Fire representative for attending the meeting and keeping the board informed as to the corrective actions being taken.

i. Stormwater Lining Project

Mr. Thomas gave a brief update to say that the lining projects will start in the next 2 weeks.

i. EDU Transfer Policy

After a general discussion, Motion 1<sup>st</sup> by Mr. Stumpf to approve the Policy on Retention and Transfer of Equivalent Dwelling Units (EDUs). 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Scalyer. Motion carried.

- ii. 2026 Budget
  - Ms. Hitchens went over the budget. Action will be taken at the next board meeting.
- iii. Mr. Cichy discussed the letter dated November 12, 2025, to PennDOT related to the US30/PA 462 improvements project MPMS#110502 and that HRG would be the consulting engineer for the Authority. He also discussed a 2<sup>nd</sup> letter related to the Cost sharing of the project. Action on both subjects will be taken at the next board meeting.
