Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Bare also volunteered to help clean up the stream banks that run through the park. Mr. Thomas can coordinate efforts of the "Great American Clean-Up" which helps the MS4 efforts. Mr. Bare was encouraged to consider joining the Board as Mr. Kasperson's last meeting is in April.

Recreation:

Insurance is in for both baseball leagues. The Diamond-Tex at Flory needs a cover due to MS4 concerns. The portable toilet also needed to be moved out of the grass.

Grounds, Buildings & Trails:

Millersville University students will again help out on April 16 to repaint the bollards in Flory Park. Linden Hall Mennonite School also wants to volunteer. About 20 students will do some painting at Lafayette.

The letters requesting flower donations will go out May 4th.

The water was turned on March 15th. The water samples were sent out for DEP testing (2 different ones). The results are pending.

The trees are cleaned up. The playground mulch will go down the week of March 28th.
