

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP  
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

**March 27, 2013**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, March 27, 2013 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Conrad Kasperson, Diane Tyson, Jim Everhart, John Lamparter, and Chris Chretien. Also present was Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order by Conrad Kasperson at 7:00 pm.

A motion was made by John Lamparter and seconded by Jim Everhart to approve the February 27, 2013 minutes as presented. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Recreation:**

Mr. Chretien stated that he is waiting for the game schedules. The Little League needs to add the township to their insurance policy.

**Grounds/Buildings/Trails:**

One restroom will open at Community Park on March 28, 2013. The other restrooms will open on April 1, 2013. The Public Works Department is doing general clean up from winter which includes tree limbs, flower beds, etc. Lights are working great and are easy to program. We are in the final year of the mowing contract. Pre-emergent spraying will be in mid-April.

**Old Business:**

John Lamparter asked about horseshoe pits. The Park Board was advised that the insurance coverage was "inconclusive". John stated that his research indicates all park equipment would be treated the same. The general feeling was this would be a good edition. Diane Tyson felt that Flory Park or Lafayette Park should be preferred as Community Park is fully developed. The Board identified the area behind the Clark pavilion as a possibility. Jim Everhart made a motion to have public works look for an area in Flory Park for a horseshoe pit. John Lamparter seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Jim Everhart made a motion to adjourn at 7:30 pm. The motion was seconded by Diane Tyson. The next meeting is scheduled for April 24, 2013 at 7:00 pm.
