

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP  
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD  
June 25, 2014**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, June 25, 2014 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Conrad Kasperson, Jim Everhart, John Lamparter, and Chris Chretien. Diane Tyson was absent. Also present was Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order by Conrad Kasperson at 7:00 pm.

**Approval of Minutes:**

A motion was made by Jim Everhart and seconded by John Lamparter to approve the May 28, 2014 minutes as presented. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Grounds, Buildings & Trails:**

A problem exists with dog owners not picking up their dog droppings at the parks. This is a continuous problem that is not improving. The problem of standing water at the bottom end of Community Park is off the Township property so there is nothing that can be done. The grade-off needed to put a volleyball court at Lafayette Tower Park is not feasible financially due to steep grading. The horseshoe pit at Lafayette Park is feasible and can be done when time permits.

**Recreation:**

The spring baseball seasons at Flory and Lafayette Tower Park have concluded.

**New Business:**

Any requests or ideas we have for improvements next year should be submitted next month for consideration for next year's budget. The Park Board needs to be careful giving permission to use the park for any type of business promotions.

**Adjournment:**

A motion to adjourn was made at 7:48 pm and passed by unanimous voice vote. The next meeting is scheduled for July 23, 2014 at 7:00 pm.
