Grounds & Trails:

Flory Park buffer will start in July. Pre-construction meeting on July 8 with construction slated to begin July 15. Trees will be planted in late summer/early fall.

The security camera signs have helped decrease vandalism.

Buildings:

Pump in the well at Community Park had to be replaced. (Brad Kaiser donated some labor).

Wood on the pavilions will be sealed this year before winter.

Horse ties at Community Park will be redone and extended from 20 to 30 feet.

Old Business:

More residents are reserving pavilions since last month. Jim Everhart requested reservation information for the past two (2) years, but should be before and after the rate change. Jim also suggested that residents get preference for reservations before non-residents for the first 2-4 weeks of the new year. The Board will revisit rental rates and policies in October.

No contact from Eagle Scout who asked to do the project in the park (picnic tables/lights on flag).

Property on Old Philadelphia Pike for additional park space is pending receipt of a grant (state ?/county ?) to finalize the purchase.
