### Old Business:

### A. LSA Treatment Capacity:

The LSA sent the East Lampeter Sewer Authority a letter explaining that they are no longer pursuing the option of leasing capacity from East Lampeter Twp.

### B. Fertility Pump Station:

Mr. Cichy gave an update on the progress of the pump station. At the current time the pumps were being put into place. Exterior improvements were also being done.

### C. Warrington/Delchester Pump Station.

In a meeting with HRG, Keystone Custom Homes asked for concessions for the pump station. None were given.

#### A. Audit

Ms. Linda Fox of the accounting company Weinhold, Nickel & Company, LLP gave a detailed explanation of the Financial Statement for the East Lampeter Twp. Sewer Authority for the year ended March 31, 2010.

#### B. Additional ELSA financing:

Mr. Scott Shearer of Public Financial Management, Inc. gave an overview of financing options available to the ELSA. Mr. Shears explained that he sent out 10 proposals for loan options. Three banks returned loan proposals. They were Fulton Bank, M&T Bank, and PNC Bank. PNC appeared to have the best offer. Mr. Beaner asked how long the proposals were good for. Mr. Shears said the PNC proposal was good through August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010, but that it would probably not be a problem to get that extended. Mr. Clark asked that for the August 11, 2010 meeting to see a breakdown of fees from PNC bank and if the 18 month loan timeframe could be expanded. Mr. Shears will procure this info for that meeting.

#### Other Business:

A. Mr. Stumpf asked some general questions on how the ELSA and the Township arrive at the amount that customers are billed for sewer.
