

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

September 26, 2012

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, September 26, 2012 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Conrad Kasperson, Diane Tyson, Jim Everhart, John Lamparter, and Chris Chretien. Also present was Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order by Conrad Kasperson at 7:00 pm.

Present in the audience was Ryan Miller and Nate Neiss representing Sight & Sound Theatre.

A motion was made by Jim Everhart and seconded by John Lamparter to approve the August 22, 2012 minutes as presented. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Public Comment:

Representatives from Sight & Sound Theatre are requesting permission to use Community Park to shoot a commercial for the play "Noah". After a few questions from the Board, Diane Tyson made a motion to approve the request. Jim Everhart seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote. (The group will rent a pavilion.)

Faith E. C. Church will perform community service at the Community Park on October 7, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (Rake leaves, pick up trash, clean flower beds, etc.)

Old Business:

The lighting project at Flory Park is on hold because of a missing part. The township prefers that all work be done at once. Estimated completion by the end of October.

There is no new information to report from Eastwood Meadows since the last Park Board meeting.

The revised Park Ordinance is under review by the Supervisors and then must be advertised.
