#### December 7, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Mr. David Buckwalter, Vice Chairman and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. In addition to Mr. Buckwalter, supervisors present were: Mr. Glenn Eberly, and Mr. Ethan Demme. Absent were Mr. Blowers and Mr. Meyer. Also present was Mr. Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager.

#### Minutes of the November 9, 2015 Special Meeting

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if there were any additions or corrections regarding the minutes of the November 9, 2015 special meeting as prepared.

A motion was made by Mr. Demme to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by a unanimous voice vote.

#### Minutes of the November 9, 2015 Regular Meeting

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if there were any additions or corrections regarding the minutes of the November 9, 2015 regular meeting as prepared.

A motion was made by Mr. Demme to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by a unanimous voice vote.

#### Bills:

Vice Chairman Buckwalter indicated that bills to be paid from various funds in the amount of \$872,015.89 were presented for payment. Mr. Buckwalter discussed some of the larger items included in that amount was a payment in the amount of \$431,053.35 to the City of Lancaster for undisputed sewer operating costs, a payment in the amount of \$49,750.00 to Allied Control Services, Inc. for upgrades at the pumping stations, and payment in the amount of \$58,800 to the Township four fire companies (\$14,700.00 each) for fourth quarter contribution.

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly and seconded by Mr. Demme to approve the payment of the bills as listed in the amount of \$872,015.89. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

#### Old Business:

a. Presentation re: Ronks Fire Company Proposed Rescue Purchase – 2017 Contribution

Vice Chairman Buckwalter stated that the East Lampeter Township Emergency Services Committee and the Ronks Fire Company are present to give a presentation on a proposed rescue purchase.

Mr. Dave Gribble, Chief of Ronks Fire Company, discussed the proposed purchase of the Rescue. He stated that the goals were to increase body storage, have more compartment space, a larger motor and a better braking system. He reviewed the apparatus highlights including a stainless steel cab and body, a stainless steel fuel tank, a 500 horse power Cummins engine, a six speed transmission, an intercom system, automatic tire chains and a 30 kw PTO generator. He stated the cost of the rescue is \$859,350.00. He discussed the funding costs of 60 percent from the Township and 40 percent from the fire company per the ESC agreement. He discussed some of the cost saving efforts including reusing reels, having a one color paint system, eliminating the light tower, installing pan type body doors vs. rollup doors and combining current rescue and air units. He stated that the fire company portion of the financing is 100 percent covered. He stated that delivery will be on/after March 17, 2017 and payment is due at time of delivery.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the East Lampeter Township 2017 contribution for the 2017 purchase of the 2017 Rescue. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

b. Presentation re: Ronks Fire Company Squad Purchase – 2016 Contribution

Mr. Dave Gribble, Chief of Ronks Fire Company, discussed the purchase of the Squad. He stated that the purchase was not in the original apparatus replacement plan. He stated that they bought a 2015 F550 Squad Unit that has 4 wheel drive, a snow plow, a 200 gallon tank, and 2 telescoping scene lights. He stated that it carries brush fire equipment, rescue equipment, traffic control equipment, spill control equipment and handles off road rescue incidents. He stated that the total cost of the unit was \$90,600.00. He stated that in accordance to the ESC agreement the Township portion would be \$54,360.00 and the fire company portion would be \$36,240.00.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the East Lampeter Township 2016 contribution for the 2015 purchase of the 2015 Squad. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

c. Resolution Accepting Dedication of Roads – Hartman Station Subdivision

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. No one was present.

Mr. Buckwalter stated that the roads have been completed to Township standards.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to adopt the Resolution accepting the dedication of roads for the Hartman Station Subdivision. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

#### Resolution #15-18

d. Time Extension Request to Record Plan – Stoltzfus Woodworking: 324 Willow Road

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. No one was present.

Mr. Buckwalter stated that the applicant has requested a time extension until February 4, 2016 to prepare and record the final approved plans for the project.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the time extension until February 4, 2016 to record the plan for Stoltzfus Woodworking at 324 Willow Road. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

e. Time Extension Request to Record Plan – Triangle Car Wash: 5 Strasburg Pike

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. No one was present.

Mr. Buckwalter stated that the applicant has requested a time extension of 120 days to record the plan. He stated that the applicant is still working on some issues.

Mr. Demme made a motion to approve the time extension of 120 days to record the plan for Triangle Car Wash at 5 Strasburg Pike. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

f. Tanger Outlets Expansion – Conditional Use Decision

Vice Chairman Buckwalter stated that this is the decision prepared by the Township solicitor from the Conditional Use Hearing regarding Tanger Outlets expansion project. Mr. Hutchison stated that the Board has held 3 hearing dates where the applicant has made their presentation to the Board. He stated that the applicant and the Township offered a set of conditions and if the Board finds those conditions acceptable then it is acceptable to both the applicant and Township staff.

Mr. Buckwalter asked the applicant if he received a copy of the decision and if it was how the applicant understood it. Mr. Charles Worsham on behalf of the client replied yes.

Mr. Demme made a motion to approve the Findings of Fact and Decision as prepared approving all the conditions and approve the Conditional Use for the Tanger Outlets Expansion. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

#### **New Business**

a. Request for ECHO Agreement – Ben Stoltzfus: 220 Lynwood Road

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. Mr. Ben Stoltzfus and Mrs. Elizabeth Stoltzfus were present.

Mr. Buckwalter explained that this ECHO agreement is for a modular unit at 220 Lynwood Road that would be occupied by a mother and sister who is the caretaker. Mr. Buckwalter asked the applicant if he understood the conditions of the ECHO agreement. The applicant stated that he understood.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the request for an ECHO agreement for Ben Stoltzfus at 220 Lynwood Road. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

b. Lapp Subdivision Plan #15-31: 2806-2808 Irishtown Road

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. Mr. Mark Campbell was present.

Mr. Buckwalter stated that the Township received a letter from the Township engineer dated December 2, 2015. He asked if the applicant had any questions or comments. Mr. Campbell stated that the Planning Commission recommend approval. He stated they have no issues with the engineer's recommendations.

Mr. Campbell explained that the property has 2 homes on it and the owner's desire is to split the lot into 2 lots. He stated that a grinder pump was never installed to serve the houses so they are working with Mr. Thomas to remedy that situation. Mr. Eberly asked if each home has its own well. Mr. Campbell stated not currently but that they will be installing individual wells. 'Mr. Buckwalter stated that in reference to frontage improvements the engineer is recommending that they be deferred and that would require an agreement with the Township. Mr. Campbell stated that he is sure the applicant would not have an issue with that requirement.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the Lapp Subdivision Plan #15-31 for 2806-2808 Irishtown Road conditioned upon the David Miller Associates letter granting the waivers and deferrals. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

c. Stormwater Management Plan & Land Development Plan Waiver Request – Seasons Image Landscaping: 1945 Millport Road

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. Mr. Brian Cooley and Mr. Tom Wright were present.

Mr. Brian Cooley, DC Gohn Associates, introduced Mr. Tom Wright owner of Seasons Image Landscape. Mr. Cooley stated that the project is located at 1945 Millport Road and the applicant is looking to add a 2,750 square foot addition to the barn to store landscaping equipment. He stated that there would be an underground stone trench to detain stormwater to meet the volume and rate requirements of the Township. He stated that the applicant is requesting a waiver of Preliminary/Final Land Development and in lieu of that are submitting a Stormwater Management Plan. He stated that the Planning Commission recommended approval of the plan and the waiver. He stated that they have no issues with the November 9, 2015 letter from David Miller Associates and are in the process of addressing all the comments. Mr. Hutchison stated that since this is a Stormwater Management Plan it does not address frontage improvements and suggests adding a deferral of frontage improvements as a condition of approval of the waiver. Mr. Cooley stated that Mr. Wright's legal counsel is in the process of preparing the draft agreements. Mr. Buckwalter explained to Mr. Wright what a deferral of frontage improvements means.

Mr. Demme made a motion to approve the Stormwater Management Plan for Seasons Image Landscaping at 1945 Millport Road subject to the letter from the Township Engineer and the agreement for deferral of frontage improvements. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

d. Time Extension for Township Review – High Associates Land Development Plan #15-32: 1861 William Penn Way

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. No one was present.

Mr. Hutchison stated that the Board has not seen this project. He stated that this is an offer of additional time for Township review because the applicant is working through some issues and does not wish to pull their application and resubmit. He stated it is to allow the applicant additional time to make corrections to their plan.

Mr. Demme made a motion to approve the request for a 90 day time extension for Township review for High Associates Land Development Plan #15-32 for 1861 William Penn Way. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

e. Time Extension for Township Review – Country Inn & Suites Stormwater Management Plan and Land Development Plan Waiver Request: 2260 Lincoln Highway East

Vice Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this agenda item. No one was present.

Mr. Hutchison stated that the Board has not seen this project. He stated that it is similar to the previous request in that the applicant is working through issues with Township engineer and review comments so they are giving the Township additional time to process the application.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the time extension for Township review until February 9, 2016 for Country Inn & Suites Stormwater Management Plan and Land Development Plan Waiver Request for 2260 Lincoln Highway East. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

f. Discussion re: Draft Hotel Registration Regulation Ordinance

Vice Chairman Buckwalter introduced Chief John Bowman who gave a presentation on the draft hotel registration regulation ordinance.

Chief Bowman stated that there has been an increase in cases along the Route 30 corridor involving prostitution and drug trade. He stated that investigations are difficult due to not knowing the identities of guests involved in the crimes. He stated that this ordinance would require hotels/motels to get confirmation of the identities of all guests occupying the rooms within in the hotel/motels.

District Attorney Craig Stedman stated that the requirement might help make a difference in the increase in crime along the Route 30 corridor. He stated it might deter some activity and help solve cases by requiring the identification of guests. He stated that not only would it help identify suspects but would also help with witness identities.

Mr. Buckwalter asked what kind of information the police are requesting the hotel/motel owners keep. Chief Bowman responded by saying they would be required to maintain a guest register for 90 days with information including the name and address of all guests in the room, the license number/registration number for the vehicle, the guests arrival and departure dates, the room number and method of payment.

Mr. Buckwalter asked if there was an ordinance in place locally. Chief Bowman stated he is not aware of any locally but there is one in Los Angeles. Mr. Hutchison stated that the case from Los Angeles went to the Supreme Court. He stated that after the decision by the Supreme Court was rendered the Township had the solicitor draft an ordinance that would fit the decision as well as gather the information that would be helpful to the Police Department. Mr. Hutchison stated that a letter with a copy of the ordinance was sent out to the hotel/motel owners but the Board may have to hold additional meetings due to a conflict in many hotel/motel owners schedule for this evenings meeting.

An unidentified woman speaking on behalf of hotel/motel owners that were unable to attend asked questions about the ordinance. She wanted to know what has changed in the past three years that would has threatened the safety and welfare of the properties in the Township. Chief Bowman responded by saying that there has been an increase in prostitution and drug investigations. He stated most of these have occurred along the Route 30 corridor. The woman asked if hotel owners are not helping the police department in their investigations. Chief Bowman responded that it has happened. The woman stated that it feels like they are being targeted and questioned the need for an ordinance. District Attorney Stedman stated that he didn't feel it was the intention to make the owners feel targeted. Mr. Eberly stated that the ordinance is for the hotel/motel owners that do not keep a register. The woman asked how it would make a difference. Mr. Buckwalter responded that it would require all hotel/motel owners to maintain a guest register. The woman and an unidentified male asked about compliance and the difficulty of employees that do not do the job correctly and fear of being punished for not having appropriate records.

Ms. Claudette Korzniecki from Flory's Campground and Cottages asked if campgrounds would be required to maintain a register. Chief Bowman stated the ordinance does not pertain to campgrounds or apartments but it would be helpful to the department if they could keep a 3 month database.

DJ Kling from Country Living Inn expressed concern about requesting ID for every guest.

Mr. Mike Martin from Smoketown Inn stated that it is unfortunate that there is a need to adopt an ordinance and suggested that it be amended to be worded differently. He questioned sections regarding guests staying less than 12 hours, photo ids, and if they would need a separate register which would create more work. He stated that he understands the need for cash transaction to acquire more information. Mr. Demme stated that there are red flags such as no registration, no id, paying with cash and staying only a few hours in a room.

Mr. Tappy Patel from Olde Amish Inn expressed concern for the privacy of guests and the possibility of being sued for giving out guest information. Mr. Stedman stated that as a private business owner they have the right to ask for identification. Mr. Demme stated that the ordinance does not compel hotel/motel owners to give information to the authorities upon request but to maintain records in the event a search warrant is issued. The Board and audience members discussed the obtaining of information from the registers.

Mr. Jeff Cutler, East Lampeter Tax Collector, stated that the State Constitution states that all taxes shall be uniform and feels that it appears this is a tax from East Lampeter Township on hotels because of the requirements.

Mr. Daniel Nafziger expressed concern about all the details in the ordinance. He stated that he does not keep names of guests. He suggest refining the ordinance and stated that he will write a letter with his recommendations. It was suggested that there not be as many exceptions.

Mr. Buckwalter stated that he appreciated the input and thanked Mr. Stedman and Chief Bowman. Mr. Eberly asked what the next steps would be. Mr. Hutchison suggested more meetings possibly having one during the daytime to get more input.

#### Other Business:

a. Planning Commission Appointment – 4 year term ending November 19, 2019

Vice Chairman Buckwalter stated that a member of the Planning Commission has decided not to be reappointed which created a vacancy on the Planning Commission. He stated Mr. Roger Rutt, a former member of the Planning Commission, has agreed to serve.

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve Mr. Roger Rutt to the Planning Commission for a 4 year term ending November 19, 2019. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

#### b. MS4 Report

Mr. Hutchison stated that he has provided the Board with a copy of the final report from the inspector from DEP on the inspection of Township's MS4 program on November 12, 2015. He stated that she spent the entire day in the Township going through the records and visiting locations in the Township. Mr. Hutchison stated that the Township is doing a great job but there are areas where we need to improve. He stated that of the subdivision/land development plans that have BMP's facilities designed and built are required to be inspected and maintained according to the plans. He stated that the Township has to work with property owners to make sure they are maintaining the BMP facilities properly.

c. Authorization to Submit Petition for Preliminary Injunction and Writ of Mandamus

Vice Chairman Buckwalter stated that this item pertains to the Township's petition to the court to have the tax collector provide certain items which are required by his office. Mr. Hutchison stated that the Board took action in July 2015 to file the original Writ of Mandamus. He stated that the solicitor advised the Township this is the next step in the process to get the tax collector to comply with the requirements of the law. He stated he feels this is important as the new tax bills for 2016 will be sent out in January and the Township needs accurate and correct information on the bills.

Mr. Cutler stated that he believes he has been complying with the law. He stated that he has secured approval of a deputy tax collector by the name of Carleen Weaver from Allenwood, PA. He stated that he believes he is in compliance with the law. He stated that he feels the Board is in violation of the code. He informed the Board that he filed a petition with the Supreme Court on November 12, 2015 in regards to the Affordable Care Act violating the 1st and 5th amendments of the Constitution. Mr. Buckwalter suggested this comment would be more appropriate for Public Comment not for this agenda item. Mr. Cutler stated that he sent a challenge/claim to the Board stating that they have conspired since day one. He stated that he has a letter from January 9, 2014 from the Township solicitor which is 3 days after he took office. He stated that they had meetings and prior knowledge of doing something to try and change the outcome of the election. He stated he won by one vote and that has stuck in the craw of the organization. He feels he has done something unique by trying to change things by giving people more choices and more payment options. He stated that he has done his best to live up to the letter of the law. He stated that in going to the tax collector convention you are going to do whatever you want but spending \$180/hour of taxpayer's money to challenge him and cause him to spend his own money to try to maintain a job that pays .75/hour when they have \$8 million to

spend to target somebody and that is what you have been doing since day one. He continued by saying this is independent of that but this is another thing that I don't know if the government of the United States has come back to you and said go target this guy because of what I did but any motion you make I've been told that you are actually wrong in your Mandamus motion and I am actually trying to secure another lawyer at this point in time.

Mr. Buckwalter thanked Mr. Cutler. He stated that this is a petition to approve the solicitor to pursue this matter. Mr. Demme stated let the judge decide.

Mr. Demme made a motion to authorize the submission for the Petition for Preliminary Injunction and Writ of Mandamus. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

#### Public Comment:

None.

#### Adjournment:

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly and seconded by Mr. Demme to adjourn the meeting. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote. The next regularly scheduled meeting is to be held on Monday, December 21, 2015 beginning at 7:30 pm.

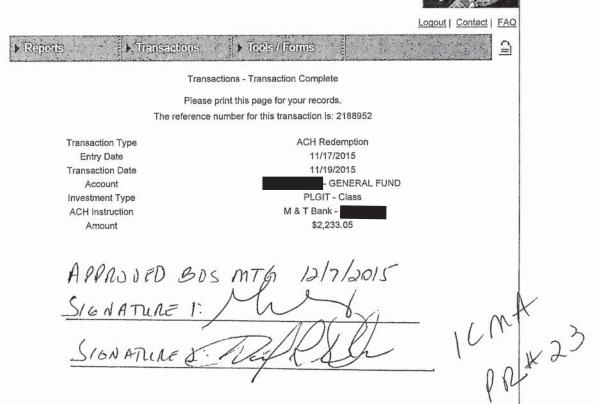

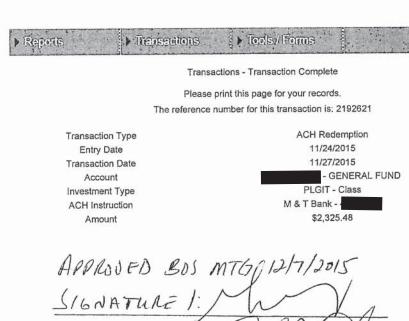
