Old Business:

A. pH Investigation/Comminutor

Mr. Cichy explained the different companies estimate to do the Sauders Egg incident investigation. Mr. Thomas explained that the investigation is still on going.

New Business:

A. Easement Agreement (Tanger) 2300 Lincoln Hwy E.

Mr. Chillas explained that the agreement will not be possible because the parties involved do not want to resolve the issue. Mr. Chillas discussed that the sewers will remain private and the developers are responsible to maintain the line. The township will notify the 3 entities that they are responsible.

B. 2016 Audit

Ms. Glick briefly went over the audit report and was present to answer any questions the board may have of the audit.

C. City Agreement/Projects

Mr. Cichy discussed Escrow Agreement #1.

Motion 1st by Mr. Stumpf to approve WWTP Special and Emergency Capital Improvements Escrow Amendment No. 1. The agreement reduced the contribution from \$500,000 to an annual contribution of \$250,000 to better allow for budgeting by the partners. The authority's cost would be \$37,325. Also approve escrow agreement for Phase 3 testing of the North Pumping Station Stevens Avenue Pump Station, and combined North/Stevens force mains. The authority's cost would be \$4,780. 2nd by Mr. Beaner. Motion carried.

D. Mr. Chillas discussed the High wants to build a community center at the end of Oakview and Greenland Drive. Mr. Chillas would like to see and exhibit A & B on the plan to show the easement and the document can be recorded.
