November 13, 2017

The East Lampeter Township Board of Supervisors met on Monday, November 13, 2017, at 7:30 pm. at the East Lampeter Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Dave Buckwalter, Chairman. In addition to Mr. Buckwalter, supervisors present were: Mr. John Blowers, Mr. Ethan Demme, Mr. Glenn Eberly and Mr. Corey Meyer. Also present was Mr. Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager.

The following persons signed in as being present in the audience:

Lynn Commero, representing Lancaster Newspapers Steve Gergely, representing Lancaster Host Harry Stevens, representing Lancaster Host LLC John Freudenthal, representing Frederick Real Estate Jeff Mylin Conrad Cullaco

Chairman Buckwalter mentioned the "Spirit of Cooperation" award that was presented to the Township by the Lancaster Farmland Trust at their annual dinner event.

Consent Agenda

- a. Approval of minutes of the Monday, October 16, 2017 Regular Meeting
- b. Approval of the Minutes of the Friday, November 3, 2017 Special Meeting
- c. Approval to Pay Invoices from all Funds Totaling \$713,936.18

Chairman Buckwalter presented the bills to be paid from various funds for the total amount of \$713,936.18. He discussed some of the larger items including a payment in the amount of \$316,827.00 to Wilmington Trust for a 2016 issued debt service payment, \$16,985.53 to Eastern Salt Company for road salt for the winter and \$39,523.00 to Susquehanna Municipal Trust for quarterly workman's compensation coverage.

A motion was made by Mr. Meyer and seconded by Mr. Blowers to approve the consent agenda items. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Old Business

a. LIDL Application Withdrawal Acceptance: Lincoln Highway East

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for the LIDL project. No one was present.

Chairman Buckwalter proceeded to read a letter that was received from Stevens & Lee on behalf of LIDL US Operations, LLC which read "As we recently discussed, on Behalf of LIDL US Operations, LLC, I am withdrawing the pending Preliminary Subdivision and Land Development Plans. Thank you for all of your assistance while the plans were pending before the Township".

Mr. Eberly made a motion to approve the acceptance of withdrawal. Mr. Meyer seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

b. Triangle Car Wash Land Development Plan Request for Time Extension to Record – 5 Strasburg Pike

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this project. Mr. John Freudenthal of Quality Structures, 14109 Ballantyne Country Club Drive, Charlotte, NC was in attendance to address the Board on this project.

Mr. Freudenthal indicated that he was representing the Triangle Car Wash project proposed for 5 Strasburg Pike which is currently owned by Mr. Frederick Laurenzo of Frederick Real Estate and is here to request an additional extension of time to allow the owner to satisfy the conditions of approval and record the plan as approved by the Board. He said that on Thursday afternoon he had informed the Township staff that they had a developer that was interested in taking over the project and that this developer has now committed to doing so. He said that Mr. Laurenzo has agreed to continue negotiations with the developer regarding the financing of the project. Mr. Freudenthal mentioned that the developer has provided numerous financial securities for similar development projects and that he is a very capable and financially sound investor.

Mr. Freudenthal also said that the PADOT permit previously obtained for the project has expired and will require a new application. He also reviewed the remaining comments on the Township's conditional approval letter with the Board.

Mr. Hutchison asked Mr. Freudenthal if he expected the footprint of the proposed building to be changed. Mr. Freudenthal said it likely will change. Mr. Hutchison then reminded Mr. Freudenthal that if changes are made to the plan that the plan would have to come back before the Board for action. Mr. Freudenthal indicated that he understood that changes would require review and action by the Board. Mr. Hutchison then suggested that documentation be required to demonstrate that an application has been submitted to PADOT within a month or six weeks and that sometime after that be permitted to allow the applicant to complete all the remaining conditions of approval and to record the plan.

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly to grant Triangle Car Wash a time extension to record the approved plan provided that an application is made to PADOT by January 1, 2018 and that the plan is recorded no later than May 1, 2018. Mr. Blowers seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

New Business

a. Lancaster Host Stormwater Management Plan and request for Waiver of Land Development Planning #17-13: 2300 Lincoln Highway East

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this project. Mr. Steve Gergely of Harbor Engineering and Mr. Harry Stevens of Lancaster Host LLC were in attendance.

Mr. Gergely indicated to the Board that the applicant, Lancaster Host Resort & Conference Center, is proposing to construct a new portico entrance to the existing hotel located at 2300 Lincoln Highway East and a parking lot expansion to replace the parking spaces lost due to the portico expansion. The property is located within the Regional Commercial (C-3) Zoning District and the Agricultural (AG) Zoning District, However the proposed improvements are all within the C-3 Zoning District.

After a brief discussion and review of the Township Engineer's comments, a motion was made by Mr. Blowers to grant conditional approval of the land development plan for Lancaster Host Resort & Conference Center #17-13 located at 2300 Lincoln Highway East subject to the review comments in the David Miller Associates letter dated November 3, 2017 and posting of financial security for the project in the amount of \$40,456.00. Mr. Meyers second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

b. Mylin Stormwater Management Plan #17-14: 620 Millcross Road

Mr. Mark Padula of Inland Design was in attendance representing Jeff & Cynthia Mylin, the owners of 620 Millcross Road. He indicated that the Mylin's are proposing to construct a patio, swimming pool, pool house, and assorted walkways on the existing 3.74 acre lot. The lot currently contains a dwelling, a covered rear patio, a small pond, walkways and a paved driveway with access to the southwest side of Millcross Road (T-548). He also indicated that all proposed construction is to take place to the rear of the existing dwelling and that stormwater created by the additional impervious area is proposed to be managed with a "recharge bed" to be placed within the front yard with stormwater conveyance from roofleaders connected to the downspouts of the existing dwelling as well as proposed yard drains to collect runoff from the front yard area. He also stated that the entire 3.74 acre lot is located within the "R-1" Low Density Residential Zoning District. Mr. Mark explained that they are requesting a modification from the requirements of the stormwater management ordinance to allow for a design ratio of 8:1 for the concentration of stormwater on the property because they don't meet the 5:1 ratio.

There was a discussion among the Board members and Mr. Mylin regarding the Board's desire to develop a public trail along the Conestoga River that would cross the Mylin property. Mr. Mylin indicated his family's preference to not have such a trail.

At the conclusion of these discussions, a motion was made by Mr. Demme to conditionally approve the Stormwater Management Plan #17-14 for 620 Millcross Road subject to the review

comments on the David Miller Associates letter dated November 10, 2017. Mr. Blowers second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Action Items:

a. Ordinance re: Tax Increment Financing Program

Mr. Hutchison explained that the proposed Ordinance would, if adopted, implement the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) program which the Board has been working on for many months and would provide a source of funds to assist the Township with the implementation of the Lincoln Highway Streetscape Plan. He also indicated that funds generated by the program will be accounted for using a new TIF Fund that will be controlled by the East Lampeter Industrial and Commercial Development Authority.

A motion was then made by Mr. Meyers to adopt the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Program Ordinance with a correction to properly identify the name of the Authority to be the East Lampeter Industrial and Commercial Development Authority as recorded. Mr. Eberly second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Ordinance #331

b. Ordinance re: Intergovernmental Cooperation Memorandum of Understanding

Mr. Hutchison explained that this Ordinance and the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which is authorizes the Board to sign, relate to the streambank improvement project being undertaken along the Pequea Creek at the Mill Bridge Village Campground. He further explained that the project is being done in partnership with West Lampeter Township and Strasburg Borough and will help all three municipalities to meet their pollution reduction requirements under the MS4 program.

A motion was then made by Mr. Blowers to adopt the Intergovernmental Cooperation Memorandum of Understanding Ordinance as proposed. Mr. Meyers second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Ordinance #332

c. Authorization to advertise draft 2018 budget

Mr. Hutchison indicated that the 2018 draft budget must be advertised for public inspection prior to Board action to adopt the budget which is planned for December 18, 2017. He also said that he expected changes to be made to the draft budget as additional information becomes available prior to adoption. Finally, he said that since the County's reassessed property values will become effective for 2018, the Board will have to take action to adopt a Tax Rate Resolution that would establish a millage rate which would generate the same tax levy for 2018 as was generated for 2017 and then take action to adopt another Tax Rate Resolution for 2018 if the Board decides to change the actual 2018 millage rate from the current rate.

Mr. Demme expressed his desire to have Township staff look for ways to change the 2018 budgeted revenues and expenditures in order to lower the proposed deficit. He suggested that revenue amounts indicated for Earned Income Tax, Real Estate Tax and Real Estate Transfer Tax could be increased. He also suggested that expenses should be lowered and then proposed increases reviewed for items such as the financing of the OPEB (Other Post-Employment Benefits) expenses, hiring of an additional police officer and increases to Information Technology staffing. Additionally, he suggested that road salt, line painting and traffic signal electricity could be moved back to the Highway Aid Fund #35 if that fund can manage these expenses. Finally, he encouraged Mr. Hutchison and the Board to plan for a balanced budget in 2019.

After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Blowers to authorize advertising the 2018 Draft Budget for public inspection as presented. Mr. Eberly second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

d. Nominations to LCPC region 3 Representative

Mr. Hutchison indicated that the County Planning Commission is requesting nominations to fill their Region 3 representative position beginning in 2018. He also indicated that East Lampeter is located within Region 3 and that representatives to each region are appointed by the County Commissioners. After a brief discussion, the Board decided to take no action.

Manager's Report:

a. MS4

Mr. Hutchison briefly reviewed the report prepared by the Township's Stormwater Management Coordinator. He noted that the project to retrofit the stormwater basins on the Township's property will not be completed until the spring of 2018.

b. Lincoln Highway Streetscape Plan Implementation Report

Mr. Hutchison said that efforts are continuing on the implementation of this plan and that the Board's action to adopt the TIF program Ordinance marks the completion of one part of this effort.

c. Draft Noise Ordinance

Mr. Hutchison indicated that this draft Ordinance had been prepared in response to the Board's request to review this issue. Mr. Demme suggested that it might be easier to defend an Ordinance that is based upon specified decibel level limits that could also address times of day and land uses with different noise level limitations. Mr. Meyer requested an explanation of the differences between a noise ordinance and the existing disorderly conduct statute. He also requested that a

noise ordinance be a simple as possible, that a restriction on the times when fireworks can be set off and that construction activities be permitted on Sundays and Holidays.

Finally, the Board also discussed how to invite public comment on a draft noise ordinance through the newsletter, Township web site and public meetings. At the conclusion of the discussion, Mr. Hutchison was instructed to make revisions to the draft ordinance and to bring it back to the Board for additional discussion.

d. Draft Gaming Legislation Resolution

Mr. Hutchison explained that the recently adopted Pennsylvania budget includes provisions to allow a number of "mini casinos" to be developed and operated. He further explained that the law provides for a local opportunity to "opt out" of consideration to be a host for a mini casino if the governing body adopts a Resolution to opt out and sends it into the Commonwealth by December 31, 2017. He also said that the Township could opt back in at a later date if desired, but that once January 1, 2018 arrives or after opting in at a later date, the Township cannot opt out. Mr. Eberly asked if any of the revenues from such a facility would be shared with the Township if the Township became a host to a mini casino. Mr. Hutchison said that the law provides that the local municipality is to receive 2% of the revenue generated.

After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Demme to adopt the Gaming Legislation Resolution to Opt Out of becoming a mini casino host. Mr. Eberly second the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

e. No Smoking signs in parks

Mr. Demme requested that the Board consider adoption of a Resolution that would have Township staff post No Smoking signs in Township parks in order to restrict smoking in certain areas as permitted by the Township's current Park Rules and Regulations Ordinance. Mr. Demme reviewed the draft Resolution that he had prepared. After discussion, Mr. Hutchison was instructed to modify the draft Resolution to indicate that the Park Board would make a recommendation to the Board as to the location of No Smoking signs in Township parks which would be reviewed by the Board before any signs are installed.

Adjournment

A motion was made by Mr. Meyer and seconded by Mr. Demme to adjourn the meeting. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote. The next regularly scheduled meeting is to be held on Monday, December 4, 2017 beginning at 7:30 pm.

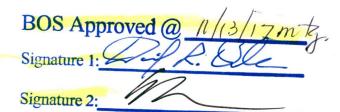

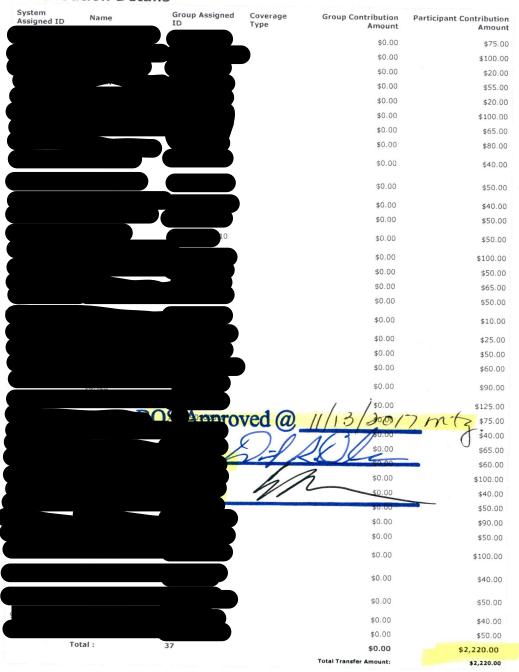
