February 12, 2018

The East Lampeter Township Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 12, 2018 at 7:30 pm. at the East Lampeter Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Dave Buckwalter. In addition to Mr. Buckwalter, supervisors present were: Glen Eberly, Mr. Ethan Demme, Mr. Corey Meyer and Mr. John Blowers. Also present was Mr. Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager.

The following persons signed in as being present in the audience: Christina Hausner, representing Lancaster County Keith Greinar, representing State RAP Gary Gilbert, Representing ARP Lynn Commero, representing Lancaster Newspapers

Chairman Buckwalter presented the bills to be paid from various funds for the total amount of \$1,107,599.44. He mentioned that \$33,527.50 was going to Lancaster County for Real Estate Tax excess distributions, \$37,815.33 to Hand In Hand Fire Company for fuel reimbursement and purchase of portable radios, \$221,120.01 to the City of Lancaster for 4th quarter sewer flow charges, \$42,630.56 to Eastern Salt Company for road salt and \$340.519.64 for 1996 borrowing.

Mr. Blowers made a motion to approve the consent agenda items with an edit to the attendance for January 15th minutes that Mr. Glenn Eberly was not in attendance. Mr. Meyer seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Swearing in of Police Chief –Steve Zerbe

Captain Zerbe took the Oath of Office to become the new Chief of Police.

Recognition of Service – John Bowman

There was a presentation made by Chief Zerbe to Chief John Bowman for his retirement and service to the Police Department.

New Business

a. Beiler Subdivision Plan #17-19: 338 Beechdale Road

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this project. Mr. Kevin Whitmeyer with Impact Engineering Group was in attendance for applicants Amos K. and Sarah K. Beiler who are proposing to subdivide approximately 40,427 square foot lot from an existing 2,467 acre property located at 338 Beechdale Rd. Mr. Whitmeyer mentioned that on the newly created lot they will be constructing a single family detached dwelling to be connected to existing sewer. He also stated that Impact Engineering received a review from DMA relating to zoning and subdivision ordinance as well as a review from HRG relating to sewer connection. He also informed the Board that the project is exempt from stormwater and that they've received approval from the Lancaster County Conservation District. Mr. Whitmeyer also went on to say that the letter received from HRG dated January 18, 2018 was addressed and resubmitted the morning of February 12, 2018 and that Impact Engineering Group does not see any issues with complying with the letter they received from DMA dated January 8, 2018 He also mentioned that they are requesting three waivers and one deferral.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Blowers made a motion to conditionally approve Beiler Subdivision 2017-19, 338 Beechdale Road, conditions involving waivers and deferrals subject to review comments of DMA letter dated January 8, 2018. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

b. 2232 Lincoln Highway East Land Development Plan #17-21: 2232 Lincoln Hwy

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this project. Mr. Chris Verarchick of RGS Associates was in attendance for the owner. The applicant, 2232 Lincoln Highway E LLC is proposing to demolish the existing structure located at 2232 Lincoln Highway East and construct an approximately 7,615 SF four tenant commercial retail building with drive –through and associated parking. Access to the site will remain the same. Two variances were granted by the East Lampeter Township Zoning hearing Board related to this project. (Section 24060.A and Section 22240.B.3) the site acreage is approximately 1.24 acres and the site is located within the Regional Commercial (C-3) zoning district. Mr. Verarchick mentioned that RGS Associates is requesting modification as per their letter dated January 9, 2018.

After a brief discussion Mr. Eberly made a motion to conditionally approve Final land development plan for 2232 Lincoln Highway East plan #17-21:, conditions involving waivers and deferrals subject to review comments of DMA letter dated January 10, 2018 Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

c. Stoltzfus Stormwater Management Plan #18-01: 2420 Stumptown Road

Chairman Buckwalter asked if anyone was present for this project. Mr. Kevin Whitmeyer of Impact Engineering Group for applicant Allen Stoltzfus who's proposing to demolish an existing dwelling and construct a new larger dwelling in its place. The property also contains a barn that is not impacted with this plan submission. Stormwater is proposed to be managed with an "infiltration bed" with stormwater conveyance from roofleaders connected to the downspouts of the replacement dwelling. The entire 3.174 acre lot is located within the "VR" village Residential Zoning District. Requesting a waiver.

Mr. Meyer made a motion to conditionally approve Stormwater Management Plan for #18-01 2402 Stumptown Road, conditions involving waivers and deferrals subject to review comments of the DMA letter dated February 9, 2018. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Action Items:

a. Easement re County bridge replacement project – Millcross Road

Mr. Hutchison stated that the County is planning on replacing the county owned bridge over the Conestoga River at Millcross Rd. The easement would partially cross the township property which is adjacent to the bridge on the south side of Millcross Road. The property has sanitary sewer and storm sewer facilities going through it. The network comes down under Millcross Road towards the Conestoga both for sanitary and storm and this is the property that's involved. The easement only covers a portion of the property and essentially avoids going over top of those facilities. The county needs the easement in order to use the property for their purposes related to access to areas underneath the bridge the construction of a cofferdam and the discharge for pump flow related to the cofferdam utilizing space on Millcross Road for construction purposes both for materials and equipment. There will be excavation of Millcross Rd. adjacent to the bridge for construction purposes. There will be excavation for the construction for the rock construction entrance providing access to areas underneath the bridge and then there will also be excavation in Millcross road for a concrete pit. Mr. Hutchison went on to say that there has been discussions with the county about provisions of an easement to use the property for this purpose. All but three items have been resolved. The three items that remain are: Temporary easement expiration date, guiderail maintenance and for the County to obtain a permit to occupy Millcross Road.

After some discussion between the Board and Christina Hausner, Solicitor of Lancaster County a motion was made by Mr. Demme to approve the Temporary Construction Easement agreement as proposed by the County. Mr. Blowers seconded the motion and it was passed by a vote of four in favor and one opposed. (Mr. Eberly voted no).

b. Consideration of Ordinance Adoption – IPMC Update to 2015 version

Mr. Hutchison mentioned that a recent court case has indicated that although the ordinance that was originally adopted by the Board to adopt the IPMC contemplated using new versions when they come out, recent court cases say the Township can't do that. Mr. Hutchison also stated that as new versions of the code come out they will have be readopted and that new versions of the code are adopted every three years.

A motion was made by Mr. Demme to adopt the 2015 version of the IPMC Ordinance. Mr. Blowers seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Ordinance No. 334

- c. Resolution re: Traffic Signal Permit Rt. 340 and Horseshoe Road
- d. Resolution re: Traffic Signal Permit Rt. 462 and Strasburg Pike

Mr. Hutchison indicated that two projects which are being funded through PADOT's Green Light Go program, require revisions to the traffic signal permits at the intersections of Rt. 340 and Horseshoe Road and Rt. 462 and Strasburg Pike. The applications for these permit revisions require that the Board approves a Resolution for each traffic signal permit. Mr. Hutchison also explained the proposed changes to the intersections and that the Green Light Go program will pay for 80% of the costs.

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly to approve the Resolution for the application for a new traffic signal permit at the intersection of Rt. 340 and Horseshoe Road. Mr. Meyer seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly to approve the Resolution for the application for a new traffic signal permit at the intersection of Rt. 462 and Strasburg Pike. Mr. Demme seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote

Resolution #2018-06

e. Agreement re: Settlement of Damages – Sauder Egg

Mr. Hutchison said that last year it was discovered that there were some sanitary sewer flows coming out of this facility that were doing damage to the sanitary sewer system. It was first identified in the city system down at the treatment facility and we were having problems at the Stauffer Run Pumping Station. Township staff did some further investigation and identified some additional repairs needed to be made. The investigative cost as well as the actual repair cost amounted to about \$52,000 of expense to the Township. Sauder Egg has offered to settle the claim at \$50,000 which staff feels is fair.

Mr. Blowers made a motion to approve the Sauder Egg Settlement agreement and release. Mr. Eberly seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Manager's Report:

a. MS4 Report

Mr. Hutchison stated that staff continues to work on MS4 activities. He made mentioned of items he would like to highlight for the month of February including efforts to get the Pequea Creek Streambank and improvement project ready for bidding, continue coordination with Lancaster Farmland Trust on the preparation of plans for farms in the township as well as specific plan documents for the six control measures.

b. Lincoln Highway Streetscape Plan Implementation Report

Mr. Hutchison mentioned that staff is still working through the processes with PENNDOT on their Lincoln Highway resurfacing project which is expected to be completed by the end of July of 2018. Continued efforts to pursue the addition western section improvements essentially between Strasburg Pike and Oakview Road to have it added to the County TIP 2019-2022 TIP. Gearing up for the TIP program and RACP project and the next round of grant applications for multi modal funds.

c. County Land Bank and Vacant property programs discussion

Mr. Hutchison mention that he and Mrs. Hitchens met with some representatives from the Housing Redevelopment Authority and that they shared information on the land bank program that was started two years ago. Mr. Hutchison stated that this could be a discussion item for a future meeting.

Adjournment

A motion was made by Mr. Eberly and seconded by Mr. Demme to adjourn the meeting. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote. The next regularly scheduled meeting is to be held on Monday, March 5, 2018 beginning at 7:30 pm.

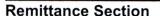

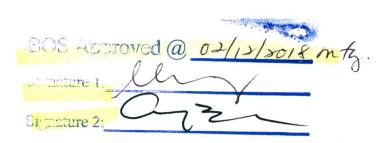

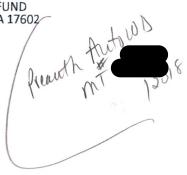
