Minutes of Regular Meeting  
March 14, 2018

The East Lampeter Sewer Authority met on Wednesday, March 14, 2018 at 4:00 PM at the Township Building located at 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602.

**Old Business:**

**A. PIM Manhole Repairs**

HRG has reached out to the PIM Corporation per the Authority's direction to indicate that the Authority believes the work required is covered by the warranty. HRG is awaiting a response.

**B. Route 30 Manhole Repairs**

35 new manhole covers that include the J lock and F hook on the underside of the manhole cover and a T-seal gasket have been ordered on March 6, 2018. Neenah said the lead time for delivery is 6-7 weeks. Penn Dots contractor is scheduled to start their work on the Route 30 resurfacing the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of April.

**C. Chapter 94 report**

HRG is working on finalizing the annual Chapter 94 Report. The Annual Average Flow for 2017 was 2.248 MGD and the flow per EDU was 219 gpd. Overall, flows have been generally trending down which shows that the repairs made to the collection system are reducing the amount of I&I entering the system. Flow data has been provided to the City of Lancaster for their use in projecting flows in their system.

**New Business:**

**A. Stauffer Run (Roof and Door replacement)**

Multiple quotes were received to replace both items. Leakway Door Company was the low bid at \$4,282.00 to replace the door. Ames was the low bid to replace the roof at \$8,590.00. Mr. Clark made a motion to have both perform the work for said items. Mr. Beaner 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed.

**B. Vaughan Recirculating pump**

The recirculating pumps help to prevent clog ups at the pump stations.
