The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, April 25, 2018 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Public:

- “Young Lungs as Play” signs have been ordered. The supervisor will sign a resolution on May 7th. The other “No Smoking” signs are ordered.

Old Business:

A public event for the Open Space Study will take place on May 9th at the school district.

New Business:

June 9th will be the Great clean up on the Conestoga, a yearly event. Upper Leacock is a site and the East Lampeter start at Bridgeport. Chesapeake Bay foundation, Penn State and Lancaster Water Conservation (ask Charlie for all entities involved) are sending volunteers.
