The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. **Approval of Minutes:**

A motion was made by Mr. Chretien to approve the minutes of the January 23, 2018 meeting Ms. Tyson seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Recreation:**

No communication to Chris. Someone interested in using the fields for adult ball contacted Charlie. He was advised to wait until CV Baseball submits their schedule.

The Board of Supervisors approved the agreement with CV Baseball Association with an amendment to specify who was responsible for lighting maintenance.

**Grounds, Buildings & Trails:**

- Stumps from the oak trees were removed
- Miller & Sons will get the water ready for April 1<sup>st</sup> opening
- Parking lots at Lafayette & Community Park parking lots are due for repaving. Work will probably done when school is out.
- Conestoga Clean-Up kick-off meeting was held February 25<sup>th</sup>. East Lampeter Township suggested that the tributaries (Mill Creek) be included on June 8<sup>th</sup>.

There were no objections. More details will be forth-coming. There will be designations for “family friendly” and “adult only” clean-up areas.

### **Old Business:**

Alta has submitted a rough draft of maps. Key stakeholders meeting will be conducted March 5, 2019. Diane Lyon, a steering committee member, expressed a desire.

Charlie will have rental info at the next meeting.

### **New Business**

Troy audited the playground equipment. The merry-go-round & monkey bars are out of compliant for safety. He gave recommendations for equipment replacement. The existing swing set must also go and would be replaced by a set for younger children.

Troy is recommending the “game Time” ringside set that is being discontinued. The Board reviewed several of the options.

Joel Motioned to approve the purchase of the Hop, Skip and Slide playset and to order swing set along with the Supernova & two spinner bowls. Frank seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

The Board was asked to think about future needs as the equipment at Flory will be due to be replaced in 3 to 4 years. The possibility for equipment for teens/adults or specific ADA equipment could be considered.
