A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER AND/OR HIS/HER DULY AUTHORIZED DESIGNEE/DELEGATE TO SERVE AS ENFORCEMENT OFFICER/AGENT OF THE TOWNSHIP'S ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PROHIBITING NUISANCES, ORDINANCE NO. 280-2009

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2009, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Lampeter, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 280-2009, Defining and Prohibiting Nuisances;


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has, under Sections 1506 and 1601 of the Second Class Township Code (relating to general powers and the authority to delegate enforcement duties of the Township Ordinance), the Board of Supervisors has the authority to delegate the enforcement duties under the Township's Ordinance Defining and Prohibiting Nuisances.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY the Board of Supervisors of East Lampeter Township as follows:

1. The Township Manager and his/her duly authorized designee/delegate are hereby authorized to serve as the Enforcement Officer/Agent of the Township's Ordinance Defining and Prohibiting Nuisances, Ordinance No. 280-2009, and shall be authorized to initiate enforcement proceedings in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance.
2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.

DULY ADOPTED the 3rd day of June, 2019, by the Board of Supervisors of East Lampeter Township in lawful session duly assembled.


