

Ordinance No. 209 of 1997

An Ordinance of the Township of East Lampeter, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, Amending Ordinance No. 116 which regulates Traffic and Parking in the Township, by amending Article III of Said Ordinance by establishing additional locations where parking shall be prohibited.

WHEREAS, the Township has received complaints regarding parked vehicles in the area of Greenfield Estates,

WHEREAS, the Township Police Department has surveyed the conditions on William Penn Way and Patriot Drive with respect to parked vehicles and,

WHEREAS, the Township Police Department has determined that safety on these roads would be improved by limiting parking in certain areas.

NOW THEREFORE, Be and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted as follows:

That Article III, of Ordinance No. 116 of the Township of East Lampeter, Pennsylvania, is amended to include the following:

1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
William Penn Way	East	A point 221 feet north of Greenfield Road and a point 50 feet north of the first point.
Patriot Drive	West	A point 160 feet south of William Penn Way and a point 50 feet south of the first point.

2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 116, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect as heretofore adopted.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
