

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD
January 27,
2021**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, January 27, 2021 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Jim Everhart, , Diane Tyson, Chris Chretien and Frank Hollingsworth. Joel Bare was absent. Also present was Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charles Thomas, Public Works Director via Zoom. The meeting was called to order by Jim Everhart, Chairman at 7:10 pm.

Board Reorganization

Ms. Tyson motioned to keep offices the same for 2021 as they were in 2020. Mr. Hollingsworth seconded the motion. All were in favor.

New Business

The Board of Supervisors did purchase the Nolt's Mill and settled in December. The former owner is leasing the property back for 3 years, but the township has complete access. The priority will be to mitigate stormwater for MS4. Resources for dam removal are available as grants. Future building use would be addressed in the Rec planning.

The CVSD has adopted the resolution to submit for the DCNR peer grant. Upper Leacock will vote on it in February and East Lampeter Township will most likely submit in March.

Capital Improvement Plan – Diane requests and idea of what priorities are for the next 3-5 years. The Greater Heritage Trail will also be on the radar in this time span. Ralph suggested that we look at the Regional Rec Plan for East Lampeter Township specific recommendations.

- Repave Community Parking Lot
- Playground at Flory
- Restrooms at Lafayette

Hutch will resend the recommendations and the board should look to list their priorities (with the plan in mind) by June. Reminder- state of Twp. Meeting – Feb. 6 by zoom.
