RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE POLICE FORFEITURE FUND (04) FOR THE 2021 FISCAL YEAR

Background:

The Board of Supervisors has, on or about December 20, 2020, adopted the 2021 Budgets for all Township funds including the Police Forfeiture Fund (04). At that time there was uncertainty regarding the amount of forfeiture funds that would be received during 2021. Therefore a limited number of expenditures were included in the adopted 2021 Budget. Since that time, forfeiture fund receipts have been received and deposited in the Police Forfeiture Fund (04) in amounts that would allow the Police Department to make purchases that were not anticipated at the time of budget adoption. These purchases are expected to improve officer efficiency and officer safety and would not be possible without the availability of these funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors for the Township of East Lampeter, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- The Board of Supervisors hereby makes supplemental appropriations from the Police Forfeiture Fund (04) for the following expenditures:
 - a. Vigilant Solutions License Plate Recognition (LPR) Packages (2) \$25,000; Account 04.410.740
- This resolution and the requirements contained in it shall be effective immediately.
