ORDINANCE NO. ___ 353____ OF 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 116 WHICH REGULATES TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN THE TOWNSHIP, BY AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 2, SUBPARAGRAPH (a) OF SAID ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AREAS ON HIGHVIEW DRIVE AND CRESTMONT AVENUE WHERE PARKING SHALL BE PROHIBITED.

WHEREAS, on September 14, 1987, the Township of East Lampeter adopted Ordinance No. 116, as amended, regulating traffic and parking in the Township and repealing all prior ordinances inconsistent therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Township is now desirous of amending Ordinance No. 116 for the purpose of prohibiting parking on both sides of Highview Drive and Crestmont Avenue in the area of State Route 340.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY enacted and ordained as follows:

1. That Ordinance No. 116, Article III, Section 2, subparagraph (a), which establishes areas where parking is prohibited, is amended to include the following:

Street	Side	Between
Highview Drive	East and West	A posted sign at a point near the intersection of Highview Drive and State Route 340 and extending 220' north along Highview Drive to a posted sign.
Crestmont Avenue	East and West	A posted sign at a point near the intersection of Crestmont Avenue and State Route 340 and extending 175' north along Crestmont Avenue to a posted sign.

- 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 116, as amended from time to time, shall remain in full force and effect as heretofore adopted.
 - 3. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
