

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD
August 25,
2021**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Jim Everhart, Joel Bare, Diane Tyson, Frank Hollingsworth and Chris Chretien. Also present was Tara Hitchens, Assistant Township Manager, Charles Thomas, Public Works Director and Lashawnda Martin, Administrative Assistant. The meeting was called to order by Jim Everhart, Chairman at 7:00 pm.

Approval of Minutes:

Motion to approve the minutes of July 28, 2021 by Frank Hollingsworth, seconded by Joel Bare. All in favor.

Recreation:

Fall Ball starts August 19, 2021. The baseball league is interested in installing dugouts at Lafayette, but no representative attended so the project may not be ready to go yet. It would basically be a roof over the bench areas so no storm water issues will need to be addressed. Mr. Thomas suggested drawings be sent to the Board.

Mr. Bare motioned to approve the request, pending no objections of the Board. Mr. Hollingsworth seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Softball league is again interested in using Community Park for practices. They do have insurance and they understand field use is only available when pavilions are not rented. (The Board approved this Pre-COVID.)

Grounds, Buildings & Trails:

- PennDOT has removed the debris at the bridge at Gibbons Park.
- There is a barn at Gibbons that has some tree issues and Mr. Thomas is working with the nearby property owner to address it.
- Pavilion Rentals are steady
- Ms. Tyson suggested looking at pavilion rental rates for 2022 before the October meeting.

Old Business:

CV Regional Rec. – a meeting has been set up with DCNR to review the scope of the grant. (September 8 meeting). Things will then move along.
