RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER,  
LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING A  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENDITURES  
WITHING THE POLICE FORFEITURE FUND (04) FOR THE  
2022 FISCAL YEAR.

Background:

The Board of Supervisors has, on or about December 20, 2021, adopted the 2022 Budgets for all Township funds, including the Police Forfeiture Fund (04). At that time, it was anticipated the budgeted \$170,600.00 would cover all planned expenses. However, given the needs of an undercover East Lampeter Township Police Detective requiring customized, Spanish instruction for his regularly assigned duties within Spanish speaking communities, additional dollars from Fund 04 are required. These funds are expected to create a safer and more successful working environment for this detective position.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors for the Township of East Lampeter, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. The Board of Supervisors hereby makes supplemental appropriations from the Police Forfeiture Fund (04) for the following expenditure:
  - a. Specialized Spanish Vocabulary Instruction – (54) in person classes of one (1) hour duration, for the employment related instruction of an un-named East Lampeter Township Detective, costing \$5,400.00.


This resolution and the requirements contained in it shall be effective immediately.


