Approval of Minutes:

Recreation:

Mr. Chretien motioned to allow CV baseball to use the fields provided insurance and schedules are submitted as required. Mr. Hollingsworth seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Grounds, Buildings & Trails:

Not much going on with winter. There is a small amount of money that needs to be spent by March and Troy Bresch recommended three small pieces of equipment for Flory playground.

Mr. Chretien motioned to approve the purchase. Ms. Tyson seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Park reservations are coming in. Mr. Thomas will have a report for next month's meeting. The design for the trail for Strasburg Pike to Oakview is underway. The Heritage Trail design is still being finalized. Bids for everything should be out this year.

Old Business:

CV Regional Rec. Plan – The Steering Committee met twice and will meet the second Tuesday of the month moving forward. To be determined yet is name, structure (voting members), how it will be funded, etc. Goal is to have a draft document by the end of the summer for the entities to review and respond. The peer consultant will also interview key people throughout the two townships to determine their interest in supporting the effort.

Gibbons Park engineering is budgeted for this year.
