Minutes of Regular Meeting February 8th 2023

Old Business:

A. Sanitary Sewer:

i.Capital Borrowing

Mr. Shearer went over the hand out Bank Loan Sale Document dated February 8, 2023.

Ms. Lord handed out Resolution 2023-01 for discussion.

Motion 1st by Mr. Stumpf to approve Resolution #2023-01 authorizing issuance and accepting a purchase proposal from M&T Bank relating to the sale of \$5,000,000 maximum aggregate principal amount guaranteed sewer revenue note, series of 2023. 2nd by Mr. Clark. Motion carried.

ii. Stauffer Run Upgrade

Mr. Cichy informed that the contractor is planning to complete some mixing pump piping work; however the majority of the work will not be done until the MCC's arrive sometime in May 2023.

iii. Cedar Acres

Mr. Thomas informed that the contractor has started the work this week and will have staff check on it.

iv. Extenders Agreement

Mr. Hutchison informed the board that Mr. Matt Crème did check into it and is ok with an extenders agreement. Staff will get a survey out to the homeowners in the area so that there would be more information for the board to consider.

B. Storm water: None.

New Business:

A. Sanitary Sewer:

i. City's Flow Monitoring Project

Mr. Hutchison discussed that there was no escrow agreement in place for this project from the beginning. The City is looking to have an escrow agreement prepared soon. The metering data indicated that the Conestoga Gardens interceptor will not need to be changed in size. However the City temporary metering and the Susan Avenue Meter Pit as well as Bridgeport Meter Pit has a discrepancy between 30% to 50%. HRG and township staff will investigate the issue.

ii. Capiital Projects

Motion 1st by Mr. Stumpf to approve Escrow Agreement Amendment No. 1 WWTP Special and Emergency Capital Improvements (Revised Allocations) which the authority share is \$37,325.00. 2nd by Mr. Clark. Motion carried.

Mr. Cichy discussed that the Commonwealth Financing Authority has made some changes to the Covid 19 ARPA H20 Pa water supply, sanitary sewer and stormwater projects program budgets. They have revised the budget to make all engineering/inspection costs allocated as grant match dollars, which increase the grant dollars. However the bottom line remains the same for the budget.

PennDot Route 30 Pequea Creek Bridge Replacement-Sewer relocation project. Motion 1st by Mr. Stumpf to approve Resolution #2023-02 to authorize the Public Works Director to sign a Utility Reimbursement Agreement with PennDot on behalf of the Authority. 2nd by Mr. Patel. Motion carried.

B. Storm Water:

i.Update on MS4 Program

Ms. Hitchens briefly updated the board and went over the hand out ELSA Stormwater Report dated February 8, 2023.
