Minutes of Regular Meeting March 15th 2023

The East Lampeter Sewer Authority met on Wednesday, March 15th, 2023 at 4:00PM at the Township Building 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA. 17602

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance by Chairman, Mr. Rick Robinson. Old Business:

- A. Sanitary Sewer:
 - i.Capital Borrowing

Mr. Hutchison informed that the borrowing was completed and the funds were now available. He thanked the authority members for stopping in to sign the paperwork.

ii. Stauffer Run Upgrade

Mr. Cichy informed that the contractor is now waiting for the MCC's to arrive sometime in May 2023.

iii. Cedar Acres Mr. Thomas informed that the work by the contractor is still underway.

iv. Possible System Extension on Strasburg Pike

Mr. Hutchison informed that this would be a challenging project because of the topography and rock underground. After lengthy discussion, Mr. Hutchison will look at the files and get the SEO out to check the properties in the area to gather more information.

v. Tree House Update

Mr. Thomas informed that Tree House entered into an agreement with Kline's to video the lines, which would then be provided to the staff for review.

B. Storm water: None.

New Business:

A. Sanitary Sewer:

i. City's Flow Monitoring Project

Mr. Hutchison informed that the issue with the cost sharing has been resolved. Mr. Cichy informed that the township's flow meter technician, Dave Moore of the Meter Guy, provided that the meters that were installed in the late 1990's are outdated and parts are not available any more. He suggested to upgrade the meters and improving the wiring at the meter pit.

Motion 1st by Mr. Patel to approve the CGPS and SAPS Interceptor Flow Monitoring and Capacity Evaluation Escrow Agreement. The authority's share is 64.64%, which is \$128,456.00. 2nd by Mr. Stoltzfus. Motion carried.

ii. Capital Projects

Mr. Cichy gave update that still waiting for the state to approve the Covid 19 ARPA H20 Pa water supply, sanitary sewer and storm water projects. He is hoping we should hear something around summer 2023.

Mr. Cichy informed that Penn Dot is working on the US30/PA 462 improvements. Penn Dot issued an authorization letter dated 3/14/23 to the authority to proceed with Preliminary Engineering.

B. Storm Water:

i.Update on MS4 Program Ms. Hitchens briefly updated the board that an addendum to the PRP is being submitted to DEP by middle April 2023.

ii. HACC Update Ms. Hitchens updated that HACC is working on an operator's agreement and the project is moving well.
