A. Sanitary Sewer:

i. Stauffer Run Upgrade

Mr. Cichy informed that the MCC's have been delayed till July 2023. There will be a change order but will wait till closer to July 2023 to prepare it for the board.

ii. Cedar Acres

Mr. Thomas informed that they are working on monitoring the I & I coming into the system now that the piping has been corrected in the area.

iii. Possible System Extension on Strasburg Pike

Mr. Cichy discussed the conceptual design plan dated April 2023 and his report dated May 10, 2023 in which there were 3 alternatives. After a lengthly discussion, Mr. Hutchison will draft a letter and review it with the board and then send it out to all the residents along Strasburg Pike.

iv. Tree House Update

Mr. Thomas gave an update that Tree House has still not submitted the things as per contract. Attorney Crème will be asked to send Tree House a letter that if the agreement is not honored then there will be penalties imposed as outlined in the letter.

Motion 1st by Mr. Clark to approve the MS 4 Agreement for HACC Streambank Restoration subject to the Board's Solicitor's review and approval. 2nd by Mr. Stumpf. Motion carried.

Other Business: Mr. Cichy discussed a manhole that need to be lined due to the cover leaking. Mr. Hutchison informed that it would be a township maintenance repair item .
