A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN FROM THE OWNERS OF 3 DORIS DRIVE.

WHEREAS, East Lampeter Township is proceeding with a project involving street scape improvements along Lincoln Highway East in the vicinity of 3 Doris Drive, Tax Parcel No. 310-98613-0-0000, owned by R. Michael Fritz and Tracey A. Fritz (hereinafter "Owners"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the streetscape improvements, the Owners have agreed to convey a certain portion of land containing 309 square feet to the Township pursuant to the terms of a deed of dedication for right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to accept the offer of dedication and formally evidence such acceptance by the filing of the deed of dedication with the Recorder of Deeds Office in and for the County of Lancaster, Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of East Lampeter Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- The right of way, as depicted on the plan and as described in the attached Exhibit
 "A" shall be and hereby is accepted by the Township and shall become part of the
 public road system of the Township in accordance with Section 2316 of the Second
 Class Township Code.
- The proper officials of the Township are hereby authorized to do and perform all
 acts necessary and required under the Second Class Township Code and the Act
 of Assembly Allocating Fuel Taxes to Municipalities (72 P.S. 2615.1 et seq.) to
 accept such right of way as part of the public road system of East Lampeter
 Township.
